RUNNING ORDER: TALL TO SMALL each ring, each day.

Standard ring: Excellent, Open, Novice, Novice FAST, Open FAST.

JWW ring: Novice JWW, Open JWW, Excellent JWW, Excellent FAST.

Awards: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class, provided that they have earned qualifying score for all breeds. Rhodesians will also get 1st through 4th place rosettes based on Rhodesians only placement in Standard and JWW. The First place Rhodesian in Standard or JWW will receive a Silver Plated Sports Car. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog earning a qualifying score for all breeds. Jump bars will be awarded to those completing MACH and PAX titles. High In Trial will be awarded to the best scoring Rhodesian Ridgeback in a regular standard class only. A tie will be determined by the highest yards per second. Rhodesians competing in the preferred classes are not eligible for HIT. The HIT will receive a silver loving cup.

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained AKC or PAL/ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Height Divisions: Owners/agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes. Dogs in the Preferred classes MUST jump in their measured height and may not jump in a higher height or any qualifying scores and placements earned will be disallowed. Therefore, if you are unsure of your dog's correct jump height, please enter the lower height and if necessary your dog will be moved to the higher height.

From the North: Take 127 south, use exit 11 and follow directions above.

From the East: Soccer Zone is on the south side of Lansing, follow 127 then exit 11 and directions above.

Notice to Exhibitors

- **Entry fees are \$25 per dog for first entry, \$15 for second entry of same dog, same day**
- Telegraph, telephone, fax, and unsigned entries or entries without fees cannot be accepted.
- **Entries not on Official AKC Agility Entry without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry will NOT be accepted.**
- Express Mail Entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- Returned or postdated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for each returned check.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms correctly and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.
- Rhodesian Ridgeback Club (RRCUS) may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against RRCUS or any official thereof.
- RRCUS will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the premises.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of judge or show committee.
- Bitches in season will not be admitted to the Trial. Entry fee (minus \$15) will be refunded for bitches in heat with a note from a veterinarian. Note must be received 24 hours before the start of judging.
- **Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. RRCUS assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.**
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.
- **Please clean up after your dog.** Receptacles will be provided.
- Overpayments of fees less than \$10 will be considered a donation to the club and will not be returned.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
