Entry regulations:

- **Entries are accepted on a “first received” basis on or after the opening date and time.** These trials accept paper and Labtestedonline online entries (see Entry Fees on third page for details).
- Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must (1) have postage or be metered and (2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to sender.
- A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- After the closing date and time, entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

The show site will be available to exhibitors on Sunday at 7:00 a.m. The building will be vacated nightly at 7:30 p.m. The ring size is approx. 90 x 95 on mats

Entry fees (per trial/day):

\$30.00 for the first entry of each dog (Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

\$25.00 for second entry of the same dog (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee).

\$10.00 for each additional entry of the same dog (includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee).

Paper entries:

Make all checks payable in U.S. funds to: **C2C Agility**. All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front and back are accepted only if legible and official AKC size. Entries will not be accepted without fees and **signature on agreement on back of entry form. Please waive "signature required" on all expedited entries.** Send entries to **C2C Agility/Christie Bowers 4487 S. Hwy 304 Rosanky, TX 78953.**

Online entries: This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com (not through AKC). During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 175 runs online (50%), 175 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Go www.labtestedonline.com to create a user account and add your dogs. Then search by state for Texas. Click on the "i" information icon to the right of the club's January trial to create your entry.

.Wait-list Policy: The club is offering a wait-list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries **after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait-list.** All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date as listed on the front of this premium. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 p.m., October 4, 2021 will be replaced by a wait-listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait-list into the trial by 6:00 p.m., October 4, 2021 will be refunded.

Course familiarization and warm-ups:

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class.

A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump per ring, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Move-ups:

Move-ups for the first day of the trial will be accepted in writing prior to 6:00 p.m. on Monday, October 4, 2021. Send email move-ups to texdandy@gmail.com. Move-ups for the subsequent days of this trial will be accepted no later than 30 minutes after the completion of the trial on Friday and Saturday on forms provided.

Attention, volunteers!!! .

Agility trials cannot survive without volunteers. The club appreciates everyone who can give their time to help the trial run smoothly. Volunteer duties will not interfere with running your dog. Thank you!

Awards: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each Standard, Jumpers W/ Weaves, and T2B Titling class. Only 1st place ribbons are awarded in T2B Titling class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Title ribbons, MACH/PACH ribbons and MACH/PACH bars will also be awarded.

Dogs eligible to enter:

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs **suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance.** No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Notice to exhibitors

- pinch collars, prong collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds.
- RRCUS and All FUR Fun assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. RRCUS and All FUR Fun and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their own dogs.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to crates when not being judged, except when in the designated warm-up area.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. IF THE ENTRY FORM IS PHOTOCOPIED OR FAXED, THE AGREEMENT ON THE BACK OF THE FORM MUST ALSO BE PHOTOCOPIED OR FAXED AND ATTACHED TO THE ENTRY WHEN IT IS MAILED OR FAXED. Entry forms cannot be accepted if they are not signed or specify any conditions to their acceptance.
- No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.
- Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry and will have a \$25.00 service charge attached.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete or **be on the trial grounds. For bitches in season, entry fees minus \$10 per day in expenses will be refunded if a vet's certificate** and written notification is provided. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification no later than 30 minutes before the start of the first class of the day of the trial.
- RRCUS reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any recourse or claim against WAG or any official thereof.

CRATING SPACE AND EXERCISING DOGS AT SITE:

We will have plenty of crating space but only the designated and approved crating areas may be used.

Exhibitor's personal chairs will be allowed in crating area and ringside, but they must have caps on all legs. Chairs that can cause damage to the mats will not be allowed.

ASILES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.

Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his crating area and disposing of any waste.

DESIGNATED EXERCISE AREAS ARE LOCATED East of the Training Center. Dispose of waste properly in the outside receptacles that are provided.

ABSOLUTELY DO NOT allow dogs to urinate on the interior facility walls, posts, ring gates or trash cans or exterior walls or posts.

Parking Parking is provided on a first come, first served basis at no charge. Exhibitor parking is available along the West side of Wright Brothers Drive in front of the Training Center as well as the neighboring businesses to the North and South. Parking is also available at the business across the street on the East side of Wright Brothers Drive. Parking is NOT allowed on Wright Brothers Drive.

All vehicles will be parked at owner's own risk.

Unlawful parked vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.

RV Parking is not allowed at the agility trial site.

Trial Site Rules

For purposes of this Trial, the Training Center and its surrounding grounds to Wright Brothers Drive are considered "Trial" grounds. As such, any damages or disrepair caused by exhibitors or their dogs to these properties will result in a Trial Committee Hearing and may result in disciplinary action

The Training Center is a non-smoking facility. Smoking is only permitted 50 feet or more from an entrance or doorway.

Chairs are not provided. **Personal chairs are permitted, but they must have caps on all legs. Chairs that can cause damage to the mats will not be allowed.**

Dog water bowls are to be in crates only in order to prevent spillage on the flooring.

ABSOLUTELY DO NOT allow dogs to urinate on interior facility walls, posts, ring gates or trash cans. **When potty accidents occur on a crack in the mats, it seeps through and creates a "river" under the mats.** Any accident will need to be cleaned thoroughly with an enzymatic cleaner to remove all trace and residue. If a dog urinates on a seam in the floor, the mat must be removed to clean underneath. **There is a \$5 fee for each and every potty accident.** The floor must be thoroughly dry prior to replacing the mat.

This is a self-cleaning Trial. The Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of the United States is appreciative to have this facility and we ask your cooperation with cleaning up after yourselves and your dogs inside and outside of the Training Center. Although trash receptacles, clean-up equipment and plastic bags will be provided, it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to bring your own tools for clean-up after your dogs.

Dumping dog food in the restroom sinks or toilets is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

BITCHES IN SEASON AND SICK DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE TRIAL GROUNDS.

Dogs must be securely leashed or crated (contained) at all times, except when in Exhibit Rings.

Dogs are not allowed in restrooms.

Flexi-leads are not permitted in the Training Center.

AISLES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.
